	Board Item	Discussion Questions
<i>The RAC</i>	Forum for discussing regulatory issues and updates, including opportunities for advocacy at the local level	1. Which activities or topics are of most interest to you?  2. Are there specific speakers or organizations you would like to hear from?
	Combine 1-2 RAC meetings per year with other activities such as site visits (i.e. to watershed or water industry facilities), professional organizations/events, IRWM projects, or networking opportunities	
	More interactive activities that involve collaborating in smaller groups during the RAC meeting, such as talking about projects, emerging water concerns, input on how SDIRWM should respond to state actions	
<i>Future of SDIRWM</i>	Host workshops, panels, or forums with regulators to discuss such topics as proposed regulatory changes, common compliance issues, opportunities for alternative compliance and upcoming legislation

<i>Future of SDIRWM</i>	Support and engage with development of a Regional Portfolio with actions/priorities, as directed in the Water Resilience Portfolio	1. How should SDIRWM engage with the regional portfolio?  2. Which organizations should SDIRWM reach out to?
<i>IRWM Evolution</i>	Engage organizations not traditionally seen as water resource stakeholders through special presentations.

<i>IRWM Evolution</i>	Expand focus on climate change resilience, including resource sharing (where to find data, contacts, etc.) and special presentations
