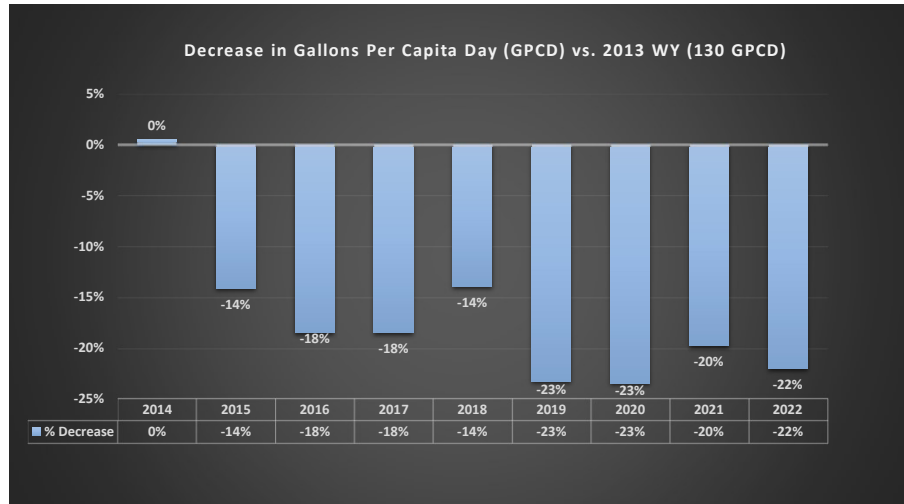

Historical Usage % of Decrease

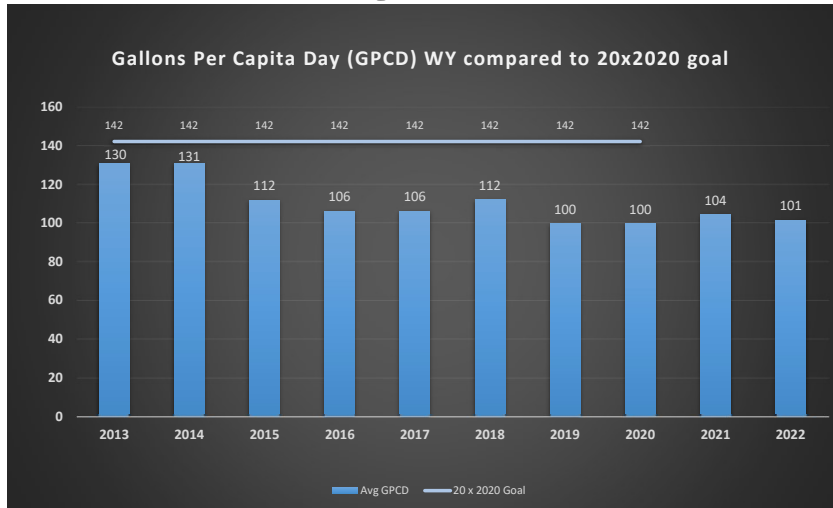

- Rain Harvesting Program - Rain Barrels/Gutters
- Grey Water Rebate - Laundry to Landscape Diverter Valve
- Turf Removal Rebate
- Landscape Make Over Classes (CWA)
- Device Rebates - Metropolitan Water District

Water Conservation Policies

- Year-Round Restrictions
 - No irrigation between 10am - 6pm
 - No runoff from irrigation
 - No non-recirculating fountains
 - Hoses must have a shutoff valve attached
 - Leaks must be fixed within 72 hours
 - No serving water at restaurants unless requested
 - Hotels must offer reuse of towels/linens in rooms
 - No single passthrough cooling systems
 - No potable irrigation for medians
 - Car washes must recirculate water

Water Conservation Policies cont.

- Retrofit upon resell/alterations
 - Water Use Efficient Devices must be installed
- Landscape Ordinance
 - MWELO must be followed for new construction and retrofit (DSD)
- Drought Level 2 Actions
 - Car washing at commercial facilities
 - No ornamental turf irrigation (Emergency Order)
