- Several project amendments have been submitted and are undergoing DWR review
- Approximately \$1.4 million has been invoiced to date
- Third round of invoices and progress reports will be due on July $15^{\rm th}$

Group Discussion of Water/Land Use Coordination


 Maintain an open dialogue between water agencies and land use authorities during the discretionary review process

- Share water (SB 610) and stormwater (MS4 permit) regulations with developers in advance of project submittals
- Host coordination meetings with the local jurisdictions and utilities
- Consider incorporating Ahwahnee Water Principals into Gen Plans
- Coordinate on design of multi-use flood control projects
- · Host an annual Water Resources/Land Use Planning Forum

- IRWM program may initiate preparation and circulation of regional draft ordinances and/or guidelines for use by all local cities
- Regional recycled water planning should be conducted at a sewershed scale with land planners and utilities






