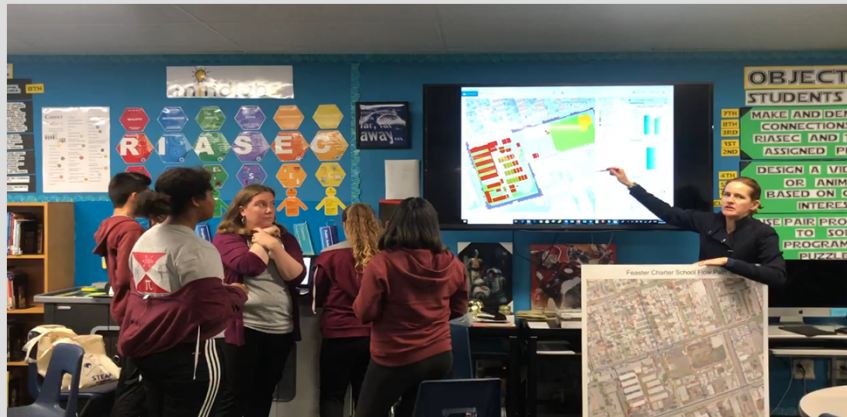
## Proposition 1, 2019 Plan Update

- 2019 San Diego IWRM Plan Update, funded by \$250,000 Proposition 1 Planning Grant
- San Diego County Water Authority Board of Directors adopted the Plan on July 25, 2019
- San Diego City County and County of San Diego scheduled to consider the Final Draft of the Plan in upcoming months.
- Once RWMG’s three policy bodies review and adopt it, Plan will be submitted to DWR.
