  - Coordination meeting held on April 24, 2019 with LPS, DWR and IRWM GAP team
  - Worked on mapping and planning of community engagements in project areas, and held community workshops and outreach activities
  - Continued work on environmental requirements and permits
  - Received approval for water system consolidation study into Yuima Municipal Water District for the Groundwater Planning for Pauma Valley DACs and Tribes project
  - Completed final project construction plans and specifications for the Storm Water Quality for Escondido Creek DACs project.


