# **Meeting Notes**

#### Reporting on External, Project-Related Discussions

Workgroup members explained any external, project-related discussions:

- Mark Project 192, Tijuana River Valley Wetlands Restoration Project. DWR indicated
  that the project is eligible for IRWM funding. Public outreach activities have included
  newsletters, community meetings, website, and coordination with local groups
  (equestrians).
- Sheri Project 207, Loma Alta Creek Retention Basins at Rancho Del Oro. Land has already been acquired. Project includes third basin of three total. Provides stormwater management and flood control benefits. However, efforts are not coordinated with TMDL development.
- Rob Project 159/186/168, Phase 1-Chollas Creek Integration Project. Project sponsors have indicated that the Jacobs Center would be the lead. IRWM Plan Objective B is addressed through an Opportunities Assessment and development of a Pueblo HU

- database. IRWM Objective C is addressed through collection of multiple data sets, both before and after project construction.
- Gabe Project 26, San Diego Regional Water Quality Assessment and Outreach Project, 2010. Arundo removal is not part of the work plan; therefore, Objective H is not addressed.
- Lori Project 209, Phase 1-Upper San Marcos Creek Nutrient and Water Quality Abatement/Urban Stream Restoration and Project 210, Upper San Marcos Creek/Lake San Marcos Nutrient Diagnostic and Cleanup Project-Phases 1,2 and 3. Reduced grant request after August Integration Workshop. 209 = 2 restoration projects. 210 = RWQCB data collection, modeling, and abatement.
- Craig Project 149, Volcan Mountain-Grand Property Acquisition for Watershed Management & Habitat Restoration. Work plan includes restoration and outreach/education. The proposed property touches a public roadway, but trail construction is not included as part of this scope.

# Review of Tier 1 Project List per Scorecard

Workgroup continued discussion and evaluation of the Tier 1 project list.

Concern was expressed that sorting the projects by Scorecard score may drop off really good single-purpose projects. However, the Workgroup does not have to use those scores as our only decision criteria; we will make an informed judgement about each project.

Workgroup moved all Planning Projects into a group to compare against one another.

Workgroup discussed reconsidering the Tier 2 project list for a second time because the truthing process showed that project sponsors were not objective evaluators of their projects.

- ✓ Workgroup members asked to review the Tier 2 project list again to identify any that might need to be reconsidered.
- ✓ RMC to resort the project list by score within each functional group.
