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Regional Water Data Management Project

- Potential Next Steps:

 - 2. Continue to Maintain Existing Website and Online System (WaterGIS)
 - 3. Provide Recommendations to State
 - · Federated system with access to multiple databases

 - Existing data management system that provides public access to maps and data specific to the San Diego IRWM Region
 - Data is periodically updated
 - Reflects information and mapping in the IRWM Plan
















Proposition 84 Implementation, Drought Solicitation Round
