### **DAC Planning Grant Solicitation**

- For activities that involve disadvantaged communities (DACs), economically distressed areas (EDAs), or underrepresented communities
- Focus is to fund <u>project development activities</u> that will lead to competitive, fundable projects that will leverage implementation funding
- "Non-competitive" solicitation DWR requests one proposal from the entire Funding Area

### DAC Planning Grant Solicitation – Key Scoring Considerations

- Most projects received full points on Objectives
- · Projects lost points on:
  - 1. Partnerships needed to specify partners by name
    - Departments within an agency not considered partners
  - Degree of Benefits direct vs. indirect benefits to DACs, EDAs, and underrepresented communities
    - Project did not adequately justify DAC, EDA, or underrepresented community status
    - Project benefits were regional and/or not specific to DAC, EDA, or underrepresented community


